ANNUAL REPORT (2010-2011)

About Spandan :

Tangra Spandan Amnesty Society is known to the local people by name 'Spandan'. It is located at **47, D. C. Dey Road, Ward No. 57, Kolkata – 700015**.

A Group of enthusiastic young men of **Dhapa Mathpukur & Tangra area** was inspired by some social celebrities of West Bengal to work the people. The group of young men sat together for a detailed planning to work for the people, with people and by the people. Development consultants and renowned social workers joined the team and a development organization was formed and registered with the Government of West Bengal on **6th July, 2010** bearing **Registration No. S/1L/72019**.

The organization started raising funds from the members, local people and different organizations and received huge support from every corner. The organization developed a platform for starting social action programs to alleviate social and economic problems of the poor slum dwellers of different regions of greater Kolkata.

Vision of 'Spandan' :

Vision of the organization is to work for the people with the people and by the people; and to alleviate social and economic problems of them.

Mission of 'Spandan' :

- a. To provide food, clothing and, or shelter to the poor person, orphans, destitute etc. and to give alms to them in each or kind or otherwise.
- b. To grant aid to the poor widows and orphans.
- c. To establish, maintain, run and give grants and aid to hospital, nursing home, babies home, maternity home, after-care home, child welfare centre, sanatorium, charitable dispensaries etc.
- d. To open old age home for old men and women.
- e. To distribute medicines and provide the poor medical facilities.
- f. To arrange financial help to the needy students award scholarships, prizes, give books and other aid as a philanthropic mission.
- g. To establish, maintain, support and grand in aid to school, collage, hostel, library, reading room and other educational institution.

- d. To open old age home for old men and women.
- e. To distribute medicines and provide the poor medical facilities.
- f. To arrange financial help to the needy students award scholarships, prizes, give books and other aid as a philanthropic mission.
- g. To establish, maintain, support and grand in aid to school, collage, hostel, library, reading room and other educational institution.
- h. To establish, maintain, support, promote, assist and or aid or help in the setting up and or, maintain center, play ground, park for public use and other social welfare work, or activities.

- i. To provide grant to public charitable institution and organization.
- j. To grant relief on the occasion of earthquake, forming, or flood or other calamities of similar nature and to give donation to institution or establishment and relief on such occasion.
- k. To provide and give money for rehabilitation of patients and to institute programs for the rehabilitation of handicapped people.
- l. To arrange lectures, debates, discussions and organize workshops, seminars etc on various educational subjects.
- m. To publish or promote the publishing of journals, books, magazines, papers etc.
- n. To establish centre for art, culture and technical education for the welfare of the distressed people.
- o. To centre for adult education specially for the slum dwellers or for the villagers.
- p. To establish center for sports, games, physical education for the welfare of the children, men and women.
- q. To raise voice against the profiteers, black marketers and to resist against the price increase, to hold seminars to form public opinion against all evils.
- r. To establish center for needle work and crèche for the welfare of the poor women.
- s. To establish small and cottage industries for the employment and welfare of the unemployed youth.
- t. To accept loan, gift and donation etc. from central Govt., State Govt., Bank, industries and private organization or any individual.

Functional Area of 'Spandan' :

Spandan is at present working at ward no. 57 and word no. 58 of Kolkata. It desires to implement its programs in the whole areas of both rural and urban communities at out side of Kolkata.

Human Resources of 'Spandan' :

The extent success of any Non Government Development Organization largely depends on the efficient manpower of the organization concerned. Spandan has been growing pace by pace with its staff, who are dedicated and possess skill over the work; They are entrusted with.

Source of Income :

Members' subscription is not sufficient for maintaining the expenses; therefore the organization depends on donation, gift and grant from local people, different organization, private organization, industries or any individual and grant of Govt. Loan from the club-members and friends is taken in time of need.

Activity Report :

2. The Conference of the Clubs' members :

The members of the five clubs, patrons of our organization and local celebrities joined. The conference in the evening of 14th November, 2010 at 7 p.m. at 47, Debendra Chandra Dey Road, Kolkata-700015 and discussed on the subject of leadership of Non Government Organization (NGO); 250 persons assembled in this conference.
